

# NEW AP CLASS & AP EXAM INFORMATION

## 2019-2020 School Year

Dear Students and Families:

There have been **significant** changes from the College Board regarding registration for Advanced Placement (AP) examinations. A new online registration process is being implemented, effective for the 2019-2020 school year.

Students will register to join the AP Class content using their College Board student account username and password when they return to school in September.

**If a student does not yet have a College Board account, he/she should create one ASAP by clicking the “Sign Up” link at [myap.collegeboard.org](https://myap.collegeboard.org).** Students with an existing College Board account should not create an additional account.

Registration to join the AP Class content will require students to enter a specific “join code” for each class. Students will be given these codes during the first week of classes from their AP Teacher. It is important students have their username and password accessible when they return to school in September. This process is not registering for you to take the actual AP Exam.

You will not be registering to take the AP Exam or paying the AP Exam fee on Fee day. Since the College Board has moved ordering deadlines to the Fall, please note and adhere to the following deadlines. The AP exam fee windows are listed below.

Oct. 15-Nov. 1- \$40 **Non-refundable** deposit to order a test

Jan. 15<sup>h</sup>-Feb. 28- **Non-refundable** remaining balance is due for each test.

The College Board mandates AP exam dates and times. You need to plan ahead for these test dates when registering for the exam. Please note students must report to the testing location by 7:30 am for Morning Tests and 11:30am for Afternoon Tests. The Exam schedule is provided on the back of this letter.

As we move forward with this new procedure, please contact the school counseling office if you have any questions or need assistance in the registration process.
