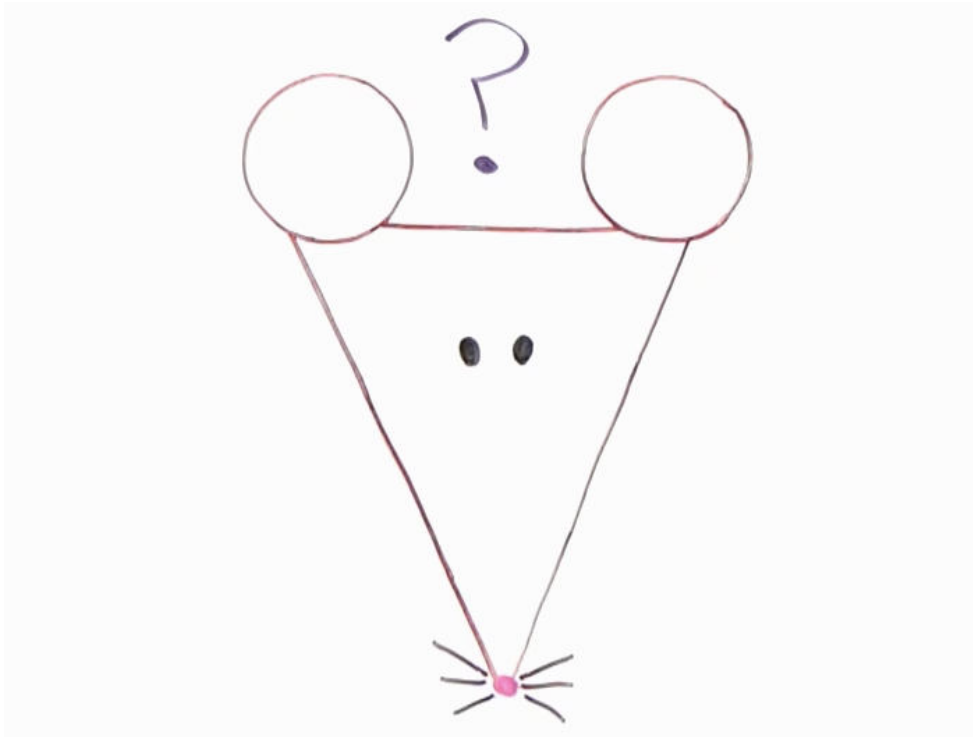
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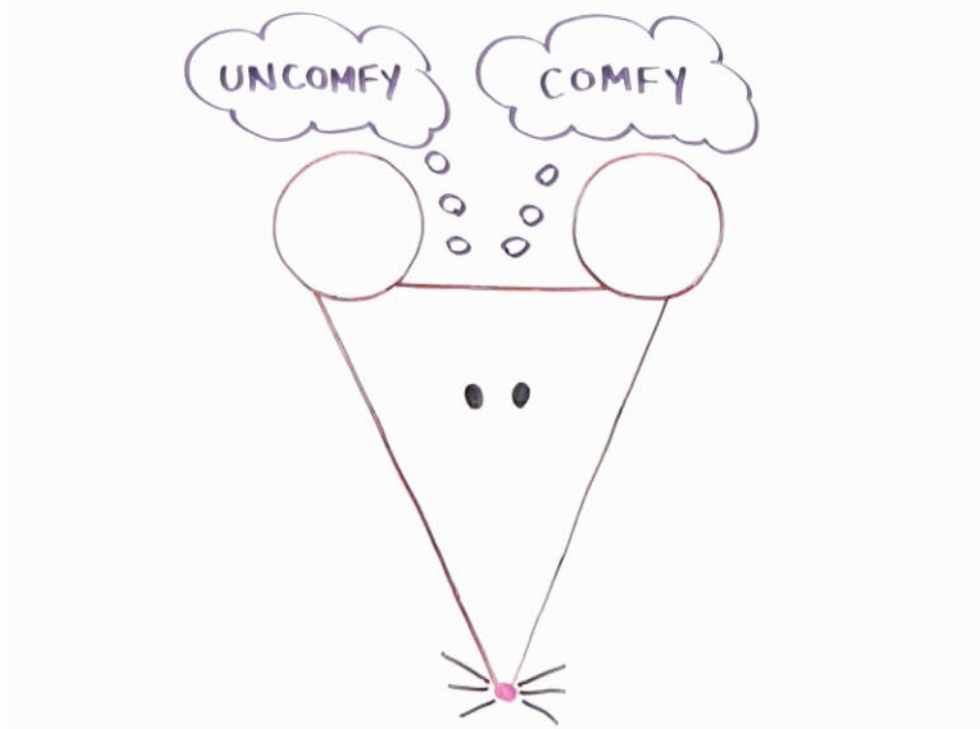
## Meet Buster

Mr. Mouse seeks things that are comfortable and avoids things that are uncomfortable.



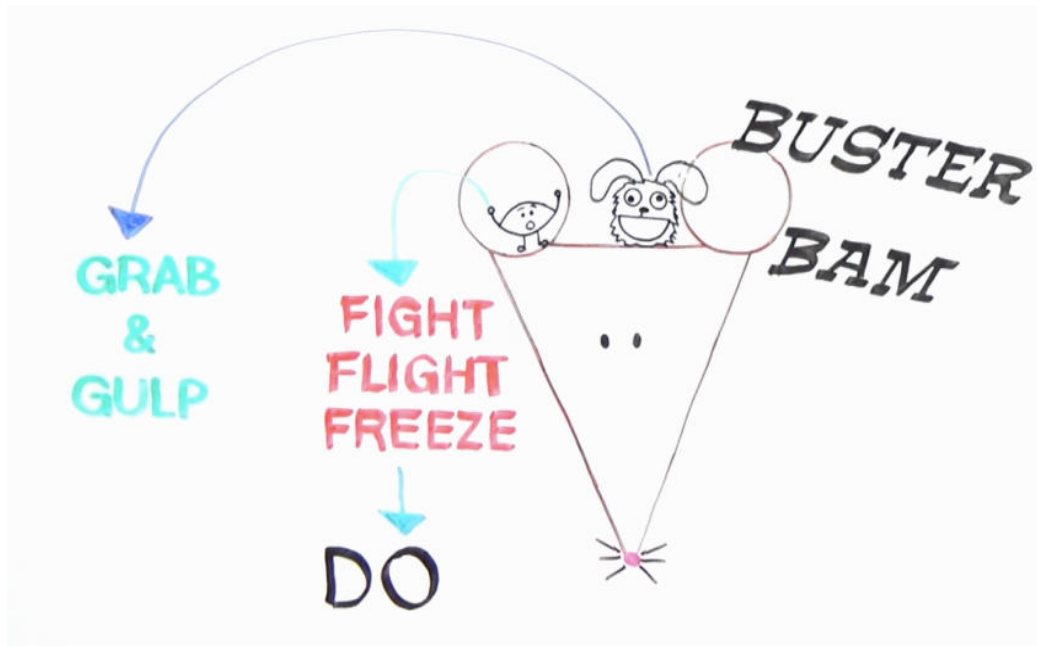
Myg acts like the brain's alarm system. If it senses a threat, Mr. Mouse has a Myg Moment, which causes a *fight, flight, or freeze* reaction.

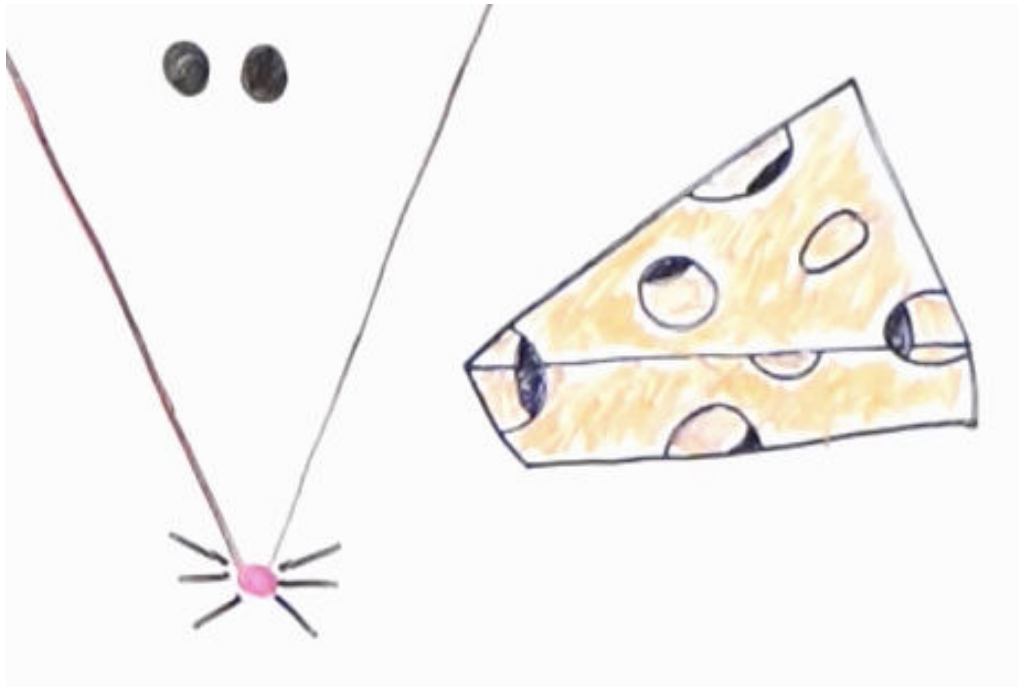


Buster is the special part of the brain designed to look for opportunities that seem awesome!

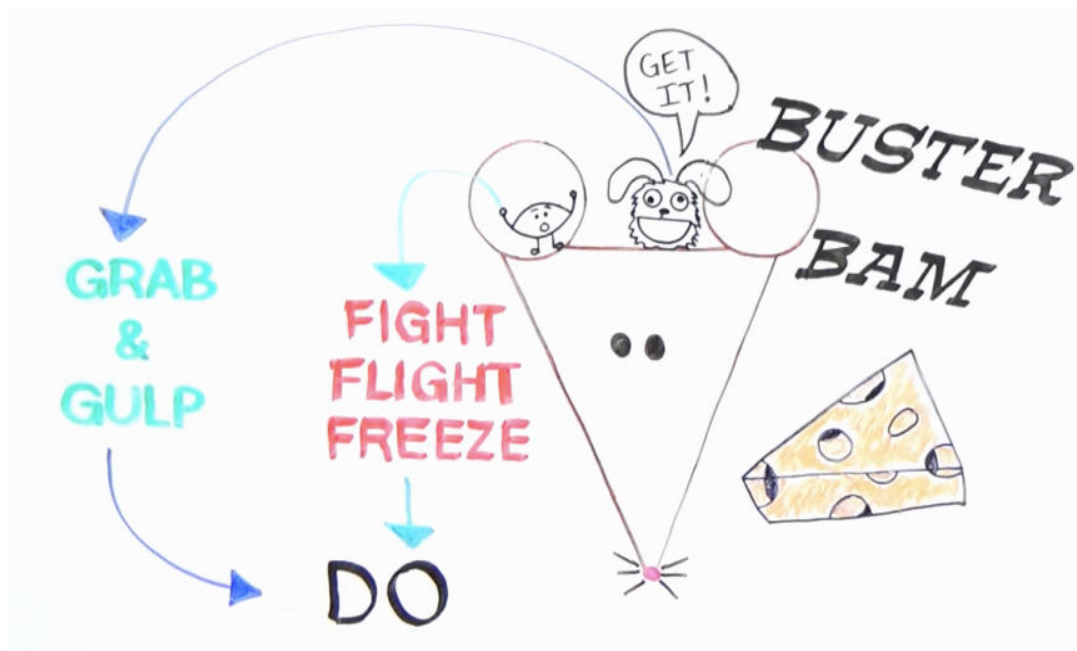
When Buster sees something that looks like an awesome opportunity, it has a *grab and gulp* reaction. We call that a Buster Bam.



If Mr. Mouse sees some cheese, which is awesome, he has a Buster Bam!



Buster tells Mr. Mouse's brain to get as much cheese as quickly as possible.



Buster sends the *Grab and Gulp* action message through the rest of Mr. Mouse's nervous system, telling his body to do it.
