

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: I have an AP exam coming up. Can I make up a lesson on another day?

A: AP Exams should be your top priority right now. Although the Chemistry Q4 Lesson#1 folder unlocked today, you do not need to do it today. You have until June 9th to finish all Q4 lessons. We are only unlocking one folder each week so that you can pace yourself. Hopefully you won't wait until June to get started!

Q: Is it okay if I finish everything for this week today?

A: Yes, but you don't have to. All lesson folders will be enabled until June 9th. So if you cannot finish the unit all at once, you have plenty of time to finish on another day.

Q: What should I do if I think one of my answers is correct but the assessment marks it wrong?

A: Email me immediately at jakrug@henrico.k12.va.us. I did not make these lessons so I don't know if they have wrong answers. Maybe you misread the question or maybe you are right and it really is wrong. If you email me the questions and tell me which part of the lesson it belongs to, I will check it out on my end and get back to you.

Q: Mrs. Krug has Zoom Sessions on M, W, and F at 2 pm, but I have a job and work until 5 pm on those days. What should I do?

A: I will record the "Teaching" Zoom session, in which I do the entire lesson step-by-step, and post it to Schoology by the end of the day on whichever Wednesday the lesson is unlocked. So if you cannot participate during the "Teaching" session, you can still watch what we did and follow along on your own at another time. The video recording and any extra messages will be located at the bottom of the Q4 Lesson folder underneath all the regular items in the folder. For example, the one for Lesson #1 Thermochemistry looks like this:
