

Limiting Reactant Warm Up Activity

How many vehicles can be assembled if a factory has 24 car frames and 60 tires? How many items are leftover? What are they?





Time for Pancakes! Yum...





Recipe for Pancakes:

- 1 Cup Pancake Mix
- 3/4 Cup Milk
 - 1 Tsp Oil
 - 1 Egg

In the Pantry and Fridge:

- 2 lb Box of Pancake Mix
- 1 Gallon Milk
- 48 oz Bottle of Oil
- 1 Dozen Eggs



The recommended serving size for Aunt Jamima pancakes is 1/3 cup of mix, or approximately 47 grams. This makes about 4 pancakes. (454 grams = 1 pound)

How many pancakes can you make for breakfast?

Which ingredient runs out first?

How much of the other ingredients are left over?

Answers to Vehicle Question:

Since cars have 4 tires, 60/4 = 15.

You can assemble 15 vehicles, and you will have 9 frames left over.

Answers to Pancake Question:

2 lbs of mix is 908 grams. Since one serving is 47 grams and that makes 4 pancakes, the box will make about 76 pancakes.

1 Gallon of milk contains 16 cups of milk. Since the recipe calls for ³/₄ cups of milk and 1/3 cup of the mix is used to make 4 pancakes, 1 gallon of milk will make about 256 pancakes.

48 oz of oil contains 96 tbsp of oil. Since the recipe calls for 1 tbsp of oil and 1/3 cup of the mix is used to make 4 pancakes, 48 oz of oil will make about 1153 pancakes.

1 dozen equals 12 eggs. Since the recipe calls for 1 egg and 1/3 cup of the mix is used to make 4 pancakes, 12 eggs will make about 144 pancakes.
