Thinking Tool

RELATE, QUESTION, EXPLORE

This thinking strategy is designed to push your thinking so that you can create your own questions about a topic.

As a class, decide on a topic or use one provided by your teacher.

Individually, brainstorm everything you know about the topic. Also, record anything that may or may not be accurate about it in the **Relate** section.

In threes, share your thoughts on the topic to come up with what you all know.

In the **Question** section, create as many questions as you can on the topic that you want answers.

Two threes then join and come up with a combined set of ideas for both the Relate and Question sections.

The sixes then share their thoughts with the class, who add new things they hear to their sections.

As a class, brainstorm how you are going to discover answers to your questions in the **Explore** section.

Begin your search.
