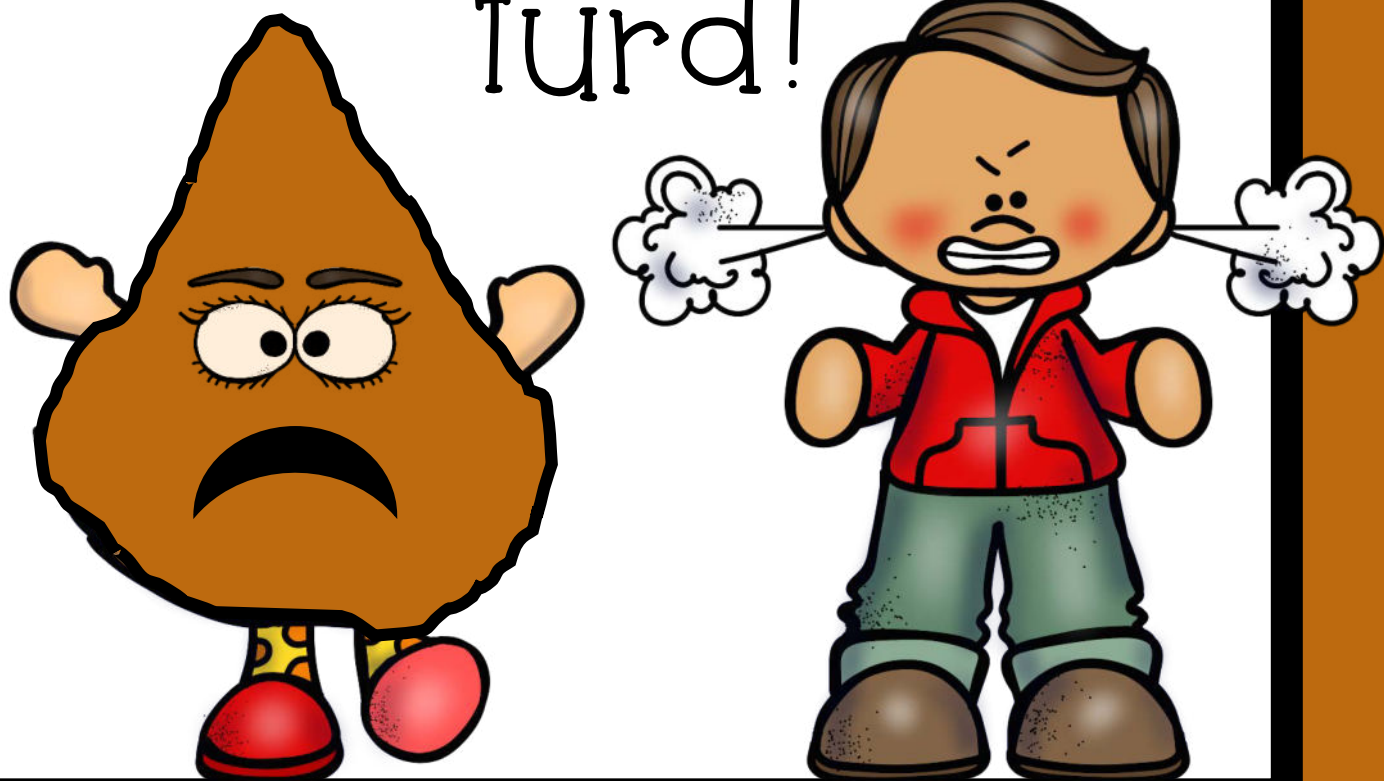
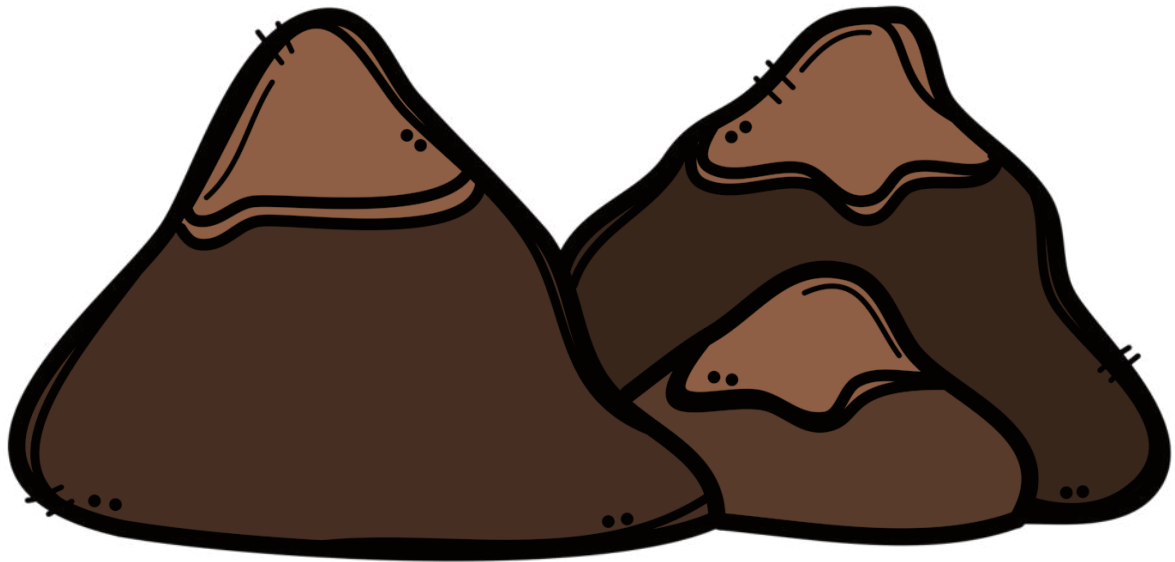

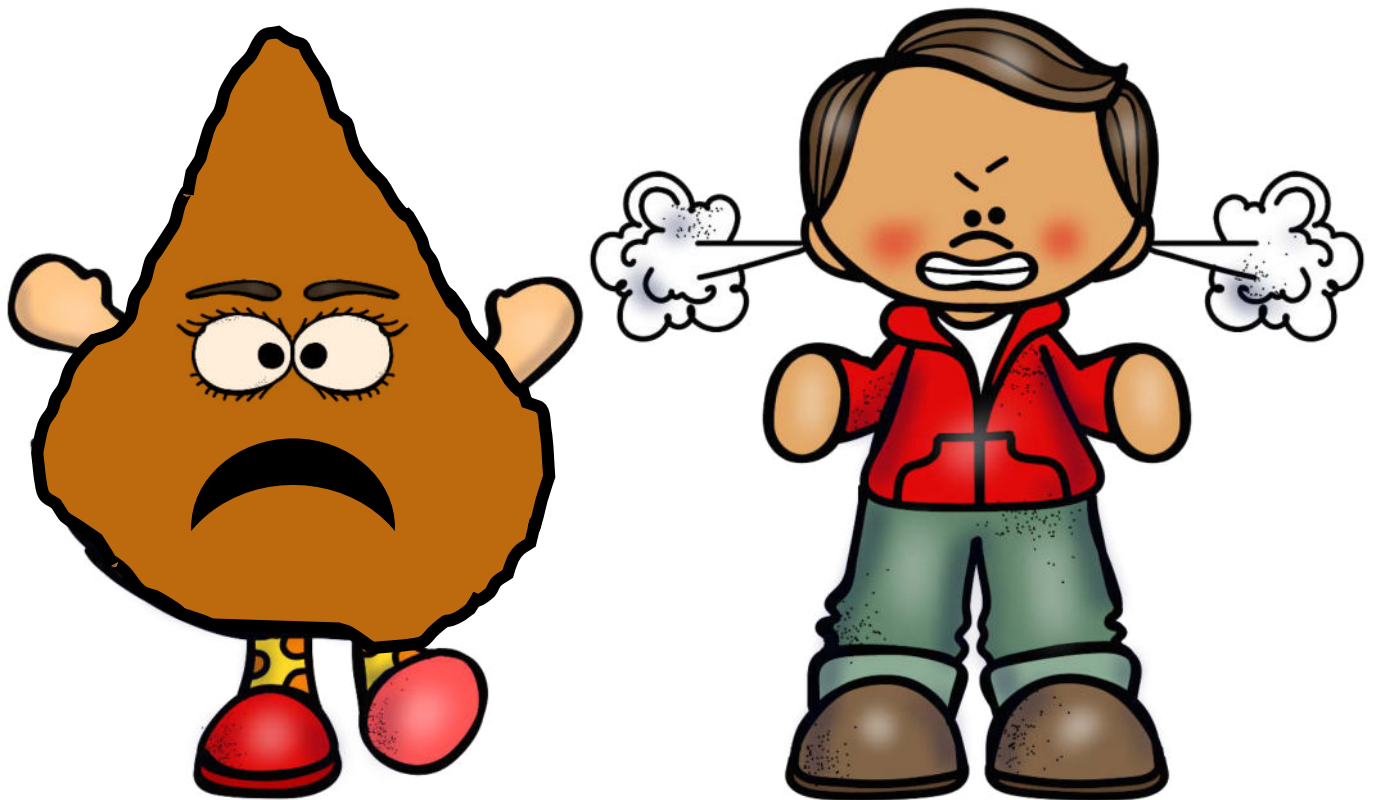

a turd today!”



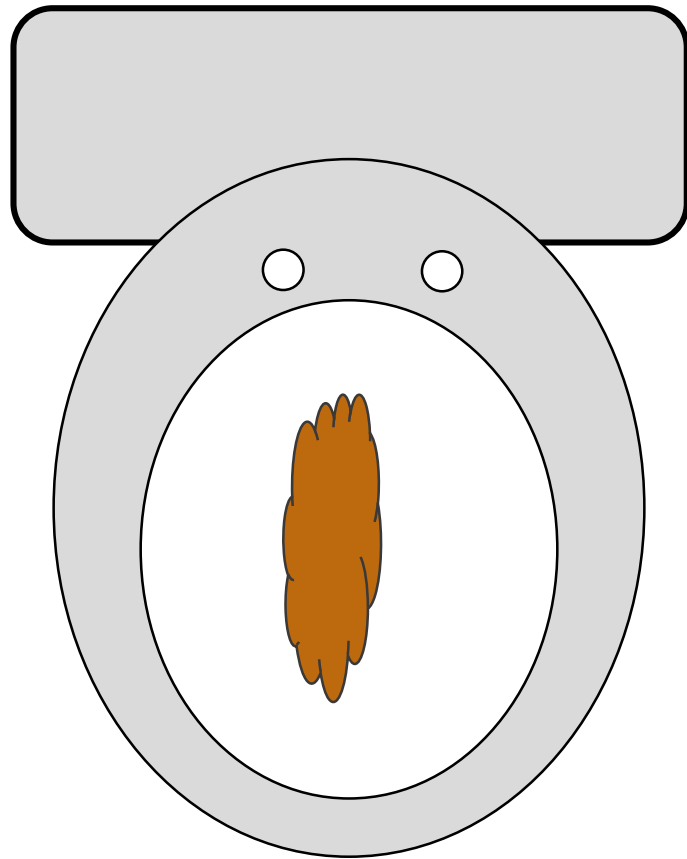
Why would someone ever

and try to compare.



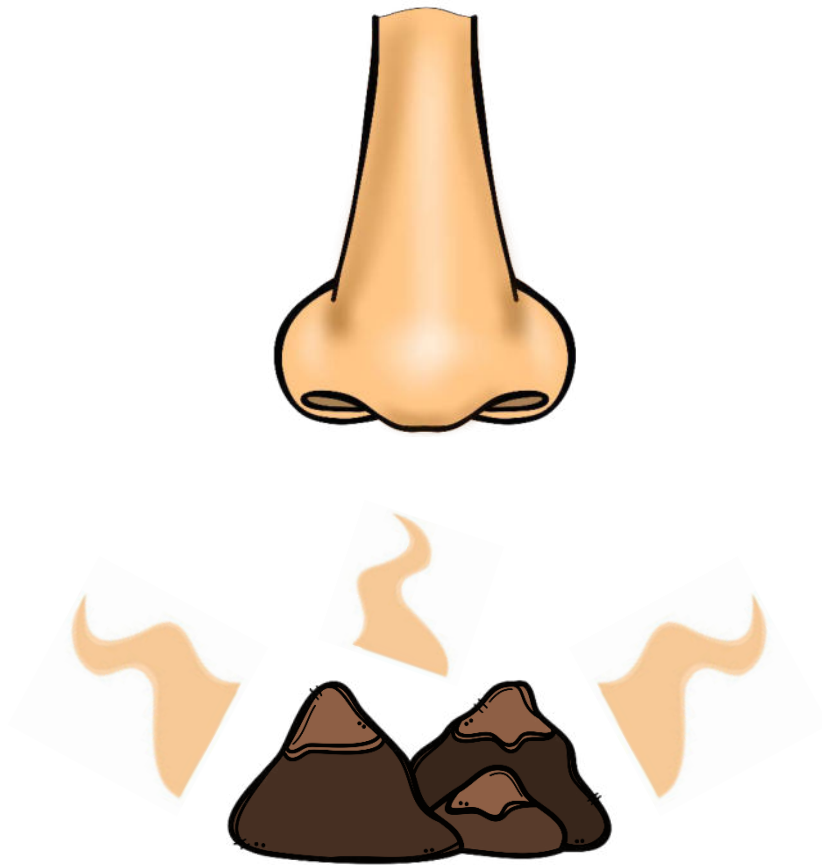
Well let's examine the facts

and then is done.



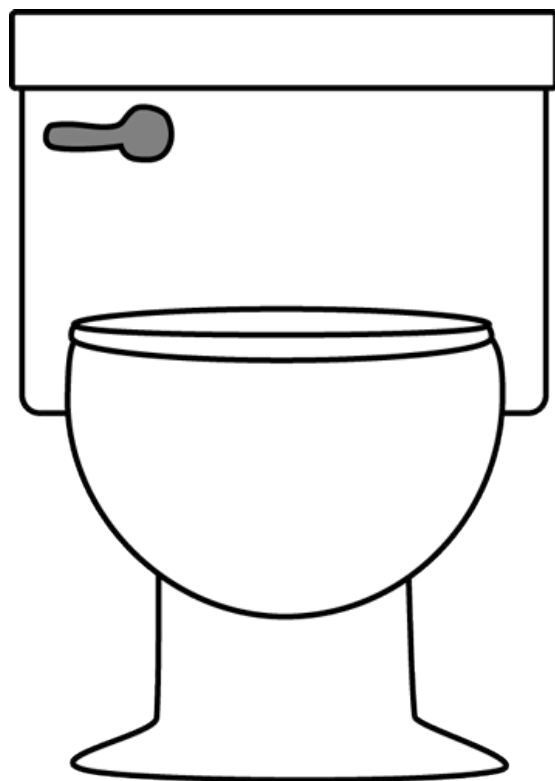
So it doesn't make sense until
