Materials: Activity kits and periodic tables will be mailed home later this month.
Students will also have access to digital periodic table through Schoology.
Laptop, charger, head phones, WIFI, etc.
Pen or pencil and note paper (recommended but not required)

Textbook: Students will have access to the online CK-12 Chemistry Flexbook through their individual Schoology accounts.

Attendance Policy: Students must submit the **Schoology Warm Up assignment** for each day by **11:59 PM** to be counted for attendance. Emails will be sent to parents and guardians, if the assignment was not submitted by 5 pm that day to alert them of the deadline for submission. If a student does not submit the warm up by 11:59 PM, they will be marked absent in PowerSchool. Parents will need to contact the school within 24 hours to reconcile an unexcused absence.

Classwork/Homework: I do not plan to give virtual homework. If students attend the live online class session, they will complete all the work during that time. If students do not attend the live session or the internet crashes during the session, they will need to work on their own to do the assignments. I will be available for help during Extended Time (M, T, TH, and F) and from 7:00 – 9:00 pm (M – F). See Google phone number and email above.

Lab Activities: Students will use ExploreLearning Gizmo, Pivot Interactives, and PhET Interactives to complete online lab activities. Lab activities will be assigned through Schoology. By state law, students must watch a lab safety video and pass the lab safety quiz with a 90% or higher during the first week of school. We will revisit lab safety once we are back in the classroom for in person labs later this year.

Quizzes: Students will have 1 or more quizzes with each unit of study. Quizzes will be open notes, timed, and administered using the Schoology lockdown browser. Students will have 1 attempt to earn their highest score. Quiz corrections **will not** be allowed so make sure to study before starting the quiz.

Tests: Tests will be open notes, timed, and administered using the Schoology lockdown browser. Test questions will require students to apply their knowledge and skills from each unit to new situations, so it is also important for students to take good notes. **This means they will not always find the exact answer verbatim in their notes.** If a student fails a test, they MAY retake the test 1 time for up to a 65% passing score.

Late Submissions: In order to allow for ease of grading and ability to give timely and effective feedback, students will be expected to submit all assignments by the end of the day of the Test. Any assignments not submitted by the testing date will automatically lose 10 points and parents/ guardians will be notified.

All assignments must be completed and submitted prior to the end of the quarter to close out the quarter grade.

Honor Code: Students are on their honor not to copy or cheat on any assignment. This includes all classwork, homework, lab activities, quizzes, tests, and other assignments as stated by the teacher.
